Millennium Gate as a Corporate Event Venue

The Museum is one of the most unique event venues in Atlanta. It offers various packages to suit all budgets. The Museum's magnificent spaces are the perfect setting for annual events such as board meetings and seated dinners, or special occasions such as industry award ceremonies, merger-and-acquisition announcements, corporate anniversaries, and retirement celebrations. All money generated by hire of the Millennium Gate Museum goes towards its conservation and care and to the development of the ongoing education, events, and exhibitions programs.

The Millennium Gate is the winner of the 2006 Palladio Award for design of a public space and showcases world-class architecture and art that draws Atlanta citizens and visitors from around the globe. The Millennium Gate, a 101-foot tall monumental arch, is situated on axis with 17th Street in the Atlantic Station development, which provides a dramatic setting as it is approached. People are drawn to the arch not only for its beauty, but also by its setting at the edge of a new park against a 3 acre lake. It is embellished with sculptural allegory presenting the story of peaceful accomplishment over the last 2000 years. It is the largest public monument to be built since the construction of the Jefferson Memorial. The Millennium Gate is not only a work of art, but also importantly, a cutting edge educational tool. We concentrate on a three-fold story: First, the peaceful accomplishment of the last 2000 years, second, the history of Georgia and, third, this city and how, because of a different credo than other regional cities, Atlanta became a giant, globally important city in a relatively short period of time.

This is a most unusual and stunning event location, supported by excellent approved caterers and dedicated professional event coordinators.

NEW... The Rhodes Robinson Room offers Italian Baroque-style for smaller occasions including receptions, cocktails, and private dinners. Lady Henrietta Spencer-Churchill was the curator of The Rhodes Robinson Room located on the fifth floor of Millennium Gate. It is an exact replica from the Pink House, the mansion built for the Rhodes Furniture family, which sits regally on the corner of Tuxedo and West Paces Ferry Road. One of the most beautiful homes in the entire city, Pink House is also one of the most historically significant as it was designed and built in 1926 by Philip Shutze and J. Neel Reid.
